

PEEBLES MAN DIES OF GUNSHOT WOUND

Coroner Gibboney Gives Verdict Of Suicide

PEEBLES, Sept. 30—Caswell Powell, 76, who made his home with William McCoy, died today at 7:15 a. m. of a gunshot wound in his left temple. Coroner E. T. Gibboney gave a verdict of suicide.

Mr. Powell had been ill a week and early today Mr. McCoy and a neighbor, George Dixon, went after a doctor. When they returned to the residence at 3 a. m. they found Mr. Powell lying in the yard wounded.

Dr. W. T. LaNeave helped them carry Mr. Powell into the house and he passed away at 7:15 a. m.

Mr. Powell is survived by two sons, Ray, of Greenfield and Arthur, address unknown, a daughter, Blanch, of Cincinnati; a brother Andy Powell of Elm Grove and a sister, Mrs. Saloma Green of Peebles.

Funeral arrangements in charge of Trefz funeral home are pending the arrival of a son and daughter.
