

Shooting Of Rarden Man Held Suicide

Services for Robert Lee Smith, 32, of Rarden, who died sometime Friday, are to be conducted by Paul Jones at Burke Funeral Home in Peebles at 2 p.m. Wednesday, with interment in Mustard Cemetery.

He was found dead in a field near his home Sunday morning by his father, Ora E. Smith.

Death resulted from a self-inflicted gunshot wound in the head, Dr. James Scott, Scioto County coroner, reported.

Born in Locust Grove, he is survived, in addition to the father, by his mother, Mrs. Eleanor Mustard Smith; two brothers, Lewis D. Smith of Rarden and David C. Smith of Columbus, and three sisters, Mrs. Arlie (Nora Jean) Ruff of Washington, D. C., and Mary and Susan Smith, both of Rarden.
